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LUXURY WITH A DEDICATION TO SUSTAINABLE PROGRESS

Since 1901, at Vispring we have been dedicated to handcrafting luxury mattresses using natural filling materials. Our commitment to product, people and planet is a core part of our brand ethos, ensuring product longevity through thoughtful design, natural materials and continued investment in time-honoured craft skills. In 2019 we pledged to measure and reduce emissions from our Plymouth factory and embarked on a comprehensive Environmental Social and Governance (ESG) programme.

Understanding that true progress requires collective effort, we mobilised teams across Vispring to collaborate on our environmental and social initiatives. Everyone from senior management and factory artisans to sales teams and office staff, we have fostered a culture of shared responsibility throughout the company.

In 2023, our efforts were validated when we achieved the ISO 14001 Environmental Standard following a comprehensive audit by UKAS-accredited certification body, SGS. Since then, we are proud to have maintained certification, marking continued compliance with these rigorous standards.

Our journey is ongoing as we continually strive for further improvements and move closer to our goal of net zero by 2050. At Vispring, caring for the planet and its people is as important as delivering the luxury and quality product that our customers expect.

REDUCING EMISSIONS FOR A GREENER FUTURE

Reducing our impact on the planet is a priority for us at Vispring. Over the past seven years, we have meticulously calculated Scope 1 and 2 emissions at our Devon factory and implemented a range of energy-saving initiatives. These include installing solar panels in a two-phase project across our factory roof, sensor-controlled LED lighting, implementation of efficient switch-off procedures in our offices, replacing company vehicles with electric versions to lower vehicle emissions and the purchase of 100% renewable energy.

As a result of these measures, we have successfully reduced our emissions by an impressive 50 percent.

To ensure precision in our carbon footprint calculations, Vispring collaborates with Lemonade, a leading carbon accounting and sustainability consultancy.

Using the notch carbon accounting platform, our calculations adhere strictly to the principles of the GHG Protocol Corporate Standard, and Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Standard.

As part of our commitment towards comprehensive sustainability, we are now expanding our emissions inventory to include sources across all relevant scope 3 categories, marking the next phase of our global sustainability programme.





A ZERO WASTE TO LANDFILL FACTORY

In 2023, we achieved a significant milestone on our green journey by reaching zero to landfill at our Plymouth factory. Among the initiatives in place, plastic, waste steel and fabrics are separated and recycled or reused, damaged wooden pallets are used to repair other pallets, and we recycle approximately 30 tonnes of cardboard waste annually.

Our commitment to sustainable improvement extends to our packaging as well. Our packaging bags are 100 percent recyclable and contain 30 percent recycled content. We continuously monitor our use of polythene and are working on further reducing packaging materials, all while ensuring our beds arrive in pristine condition.

In a world where sustainability matters more than ever, Vispring stands out as a beacon of mindful craftsmanship. Our commitment to enduring quality echoes through every stitch, reflecting a conscious shift away from disposable consumer culture towards a product that endures.

At the heart of Vispring lies a heritage rooted in tradition and natural materials. For over a century, we've upheld the artistry of luxury mattress-making, using only the finest British fleece wool, cotton, cashmere, mohair, and silk filling materials. Each one is handpicked for its innate qualities - softness, breathability, loft and natural spring - ensuring longevity and resilience without

compromise.

Unlike mass-produced alternatives, every Vispring mattress is meticulously handcrafted by generations of skilled artisans in our Plymouth factory; free from glue, foam, or harmful chemical treatments. Our pocket springs, encased in unbleached cotton calico pockets, remain entirely glue free, preserving both quality and integrity.

A Vispring bed isn't just a purchase; it's an investment in lasting comfort. With a steadfast commitment to quality, we proudly offer a 30-year guarantee, safeguarding against any faults in craftsmanship or materials.

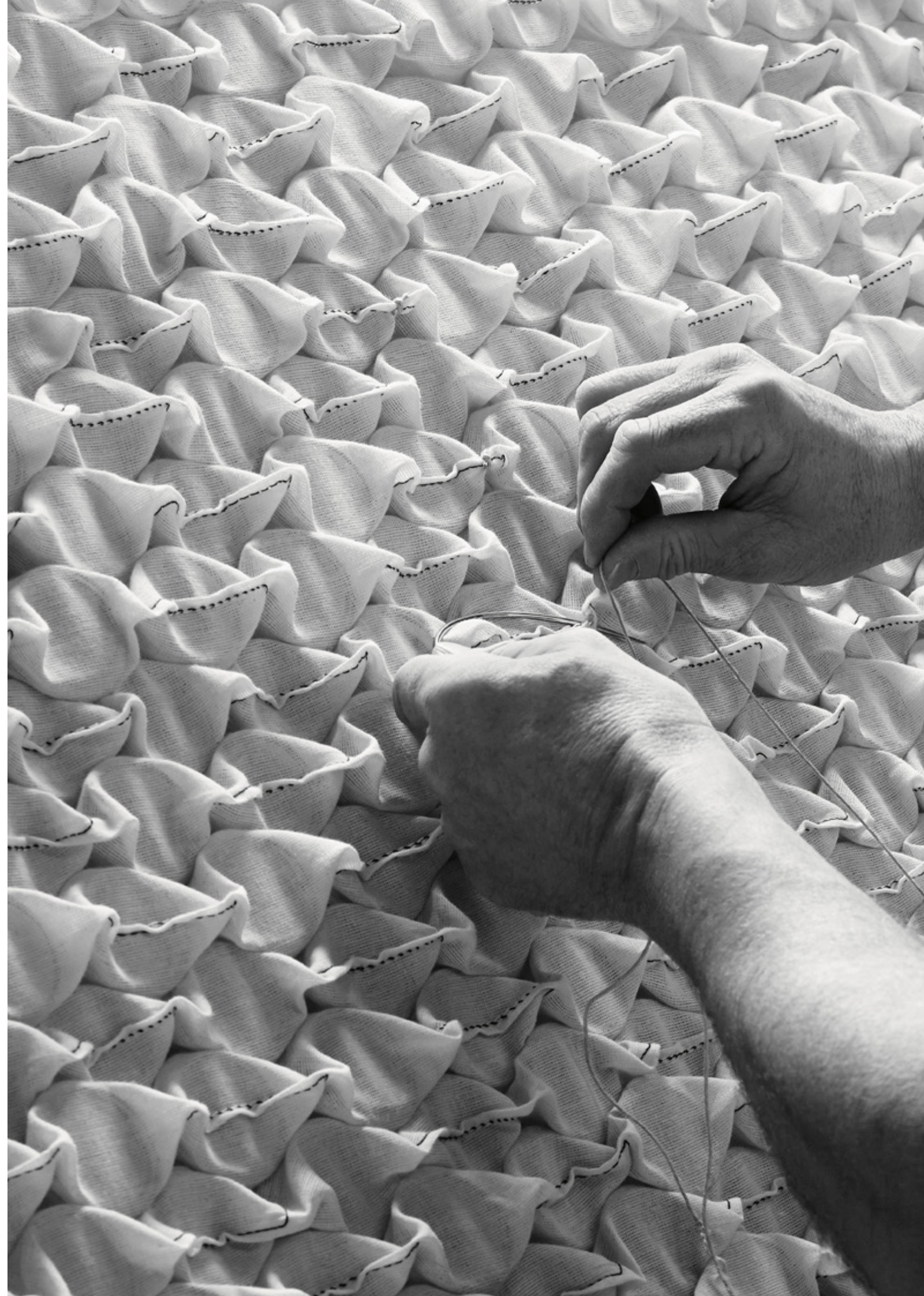

PARTNERING FOR POSITIVE IMPACT

We believe in the transformative power of a good night's sleep. That's why we're committed to ensuring that our surplus and returned, 'good as new' beds can be supplied to those most in need. Through strategic partnerships with respected charitable organisations, we're able to extend the gift of quality rest to deprived communities around the world.

Since 2005, we've collaborated closely with 'In Kind Direct', a charitable initiative founded by King Charles III. This esteemed organisation specialises in distributing usable consumer goods from manufacturers and retailers to British charities, both domestically and abroad. Through this partnership, we've been able to channel our surplus beds to those who need them most.

In tandem with 'Mission Without Borders', Vispring

has made a substantial impact in Eastern Europe. Over the years, we've proudly donated 445 container loads of our products, including more than 14,900 mattresses and 8,500 divan sets. Working tirelessly in regions affected by poverty and oppression, 'Mission Without Borders' provides essential items like beds, bedding, clothing, hygiene products, and school supplies to families in need across Ukraine, Moldova, Romania, Bulgaria, Bosnia-Herzegovina, and Albania.

By joining forces with these reputable organisations, Vispring is not only contributing to positive social change but also ensuring that our ESG commitment extends far beyond the boundaries of our business. Together, we're making a tangible difference in the lives of individuals and communities, one good night's sleep at a time.

SOURCING FOR A BETTER TOMORROW

As a proud British brand, we prioritise sourcing locally whenever possible. We currently source 84 percent of materials from the UK, 26 percent of which are in the southwest of England, having fostered strong relationships with local suppliers over many years.

A cornerstone of our beds is pure British fleece wool sourced from across the UK. Annually, we utilise more than 300 tons of this naturally renewable fibre, significantly reducing our environmental footprint compared to artificial alternatives. Not only is wool inherently fire retardant, thanks to its keratin content, but its production also requires far less energy than manmade fibres.

Since joining the Campaign for Wool in 2010, Vispring has been a steadfast supporter of UK wool producers. We're committed to purchasing a substantial portion of the Shetland Island crofters' wool clip each year, ensuring fair compensation and sustainability for these remote Scottish communities. Additionally, our partnership with

local farms in Devon and Somerset allows us to source wool for our mattresses from farms close to our Plymouth factory.

In 2021, we introduced the Limited-Edition Lana mattress, now named the Charlotte, crafted from pure fleece wool of the Exmoor Horn sheep, a minority breed. With each Charlotte mattress sold, Vispring contributes directly to Exmoor Horn farmers, supporting the preservation of this heritage breed for future generations.

While we prioritise local sourcing, we also seek out the finest natural materials globally to achieve our signature comfort. As a member of SEDEX, we monitor ethical standards and transparency in our global supply chain, seeking fair treatment of workers and responsible sourcing practices.

At Vispring, we are on a journey towards a better future— one where quality, ethics, and environmental responsibility converge seamlessly in every Vispring bed.





PRODUCT CARBON FOOTPRINT

In 2026 we began a pilot Product Carbon Footprint Project to measure the cradle-to-grave embodied emissions for each size of mattress within the most popular product in our mattress range.

A key objective in all our sustainability efforts is enhancing transparency with our stakeholders and ourselves. We believe the most effective way to reduce our impact on the environment is by understanding the key emission sources within our value chain and using this insight to progressively reduce emissions throughout our supply chain, from materials sourcing, product design, manufacturing, and distribution, to end-of-life.

The goal is to provide focus across the business on the environmental impact of our operations; from purchasing through to after-sales. We believe this will position Vispring among the UK's most transparent luxury bed manufacturers. Over the next 5 years, optimising our supply chain will enable us to reduce our cradle-to-grave emissions and make significant improvements to avoided emissions.

END OF LIFE RECYCLING

Handcrafted with care at our UK factory, every Vispring bed is a testament to enduring quality. Designed to provide years, even decades, of restful sleep, each mattress is far from being a disposable item— it's built to last.

When the time comes to replace your Vispring mattress, rest assured that its main components, such as steel and wood can be recycled. Materials recycling has some way to go, and as a business we are doing all we can to explore recycling routes for waste materials. However, natural fibre fillings can be converted into energy through waste recovery processes. To ensure this environmentally friendly pathway and prevent unnecessary landfill waste, it's essential to dispose of your mattress responsibly through a reputable recycling service.

In the UK and overseas, our luxury beds are available through a network of trusted retailers, many of whom offer collection and recycling services for unwanted mattresses. If this option isn't available, we ask our customers to seek a reputable recycling service. In the

UK we recommend The Furniture Recycling Group, a registered, nationwide bed recycling service to arrange a home collection, knowing that each mattress and divan base collected is handled through a secure chain of custody and recycled at certified facilities. Collection costs vary based on location, size and quantity.

We encourage our customers outside the UK to consult with their Vispring retailer to explore responsible disposal options.

Together, we can work towards eliminating waste from landfills by disposing of unwanted mattresses responsibly. In the meantime, Vispring remains committed to designing with sustainability in mind, reducing waste at source, and collaborating with our suppliers, retailers, and recycling partners to ensure recyclability.

CONSERVING OUR PLANET'S TREASURES

As a global brand, we recognise the urgent need to safeguard our planet's precious ecosystems. Vispring proudly supports the World Land Trust (WLT), an organisation dedicated to protecting and sustainably managing natural habitats worldwide to preserve biodiversity, especially in areas facing imminent threat.

Through our partnership with WLT's 'Buy an Acre' program, Vispring is making a tangible impact by funding the protection of 50 acres of endangered habitat, at risk from deforestation, bringing it within nature reserves, which will be protected in perpetuity for wildlife and biodiversity. Saving the world's last remaining forests is a crucial way of tackling climate change head on. Buy an Acre funds are currently supporting land protection projects in Argentina, Ecuador, Kenya, Patagonia Argentina, South Africa and Uganda.

In northern Argentina, our support is helping protect

one of South America's most threatened ecosystems: the Dry Chaco Forest. Once stretching across vast swathes of Argentina's Córdoba Province, today just 5 per cent remains – devastated by decades of logging, wildfires, and cattle ranching. Traslasierra National Park was declared in 2018 to protect what remains. Despite the park's vast 260,412 acres (105,385 ha), much of the land within its legal boundary remains privately owned, making it challenging for the National Parks Administration to manage effectively. Now, with WLT's support, Aves Argentinas is securing privately held land and donating it to the park, ensuring the protection of this extraordinary landscape and its threatened species.

Our commitment to protecting global ecosystems goes beyond words—it's about taking concrete action to ensure a brighter, more sustainable future for generations to come.

VISPRING COMMUNITY

Vispring is built on a strong community of craftspeople, suppliers, retailers and part-ners across the globe, each one playing a vital and valued part of our business. People are at the very heart of everything we do.

Within our Plymouth factory generations of families still apply their dedication and craft and it's vitally important to us that we nurture this through training and development. As part of this, 2026 marks the start of our apprenticeship programme.

Vispring formed part of the national cohort to design, build and create this apprentice-ship, which was approved by the national governing body in 2025. Our first apprentice will be completing the inaugural apprenticeship later this year.

The scheme is part of our ongoing commitment to upskilling new workers, creating new industry career opportunities, and keeping traditional craft skills alive.

At Vispring we are committed to continued, gradual, consistent and transparent steps towards environmental improvement, keeping product, people and planet at the heart of everything we do.
